EVENT DETAILS

Venue: Park Mammoth Golf Club

Date: Saturday & Sunday September 12&13

Tee Times: Single Tee starting at 12:36pm CST Saturday and 12:36pm CST Sunday

Tee Box Selection:

- Caveman/Cambridge/Bluegrass Flights: Black Tees (6200 Yds)
- Cardinal Flight: Gold Tees (5500 Yards)

Format: 36 Hole Individual Stroke Play

OPTIONAL GAMES

NET SKINS: \$20/Player per Day

GROSS SKINS: \$20/Player per Day

Contest Holes: \$20 for the tournament

Players will be capped at 18 strokes for SKINS GAME ONLY

RULES SHEET

1. USGA Rules will be in effect. Local HBF Tour Rules will be listed below.
2. Pace of Play policy:
 - a. All players are going to be held to a strict 4 hours and 30 minute schedule
 - b. Tournament ambassador will confirm pace of play.
 - c. Groups found out of position will be handled as follows:
 - i. Verbal warning—1st offense
 - ii. All Players in out of position groups will be put on 45 second shot clock—2nd offense
 - iii. Players that violate the shot clock will be given 1 stroke penalty—3rd offense
 - iv. Players that violate the shot clock for a second time—Tournament DQ and removal from course
3. Scoring—All Players are required to write and enter their GROSS or actual scores on the scorecards and scoring system. Leaderboard King Software will adjust the scoring to a NET Point total.
4. USGA and HBF Tour require all players to play "READY GOLF". If the green is open ahead of you, players are required to play their shot, prior to helping other competitors locate their balls.
5. **MAX SCORE POLICY:** Once players reach NET Double Bogey, they must pick up and continue to the next hole. No Exceptions. Players that don't abide by this rule will receive one verbal warning, and the second violation will lead to removal from event. All negative points are the same once players reach NET Double Bogey.
6. 14 Club Rule is in effect. Range finders/yardage devices are allowed, but slope and other options must be DISABLED.
7. The Ball will be played DOWN Everywhere, pending weather updates as the event gets closer.
8. Players must switch cards on the first tee box and keep opponents scores throughout the round.
9. All areas that are out of bounds, will be played as OUT OF BOUNDS and the player must retee. (Stroke + Distance) All areas inside the boundary of the golf course, will be played as lateral hazard. ALL ROADS ARE RULED OUT OF BOUNDS.
If you hit a ball into a neighbors yard, or off golf course property—Hit another ball from the last spot played
If you hit a ball into woods, water, etc. within the boundaries of the golf course—Play as lateral hazard
10. ALL PUTTS MUST BE HOLED OUT.
11. Tie Breaking Procedure:
 - a. All Flight winners rs will be required to compete in a sudden death play-off.
 - b. All other spots are determined by the USGA System: Last 9, Last 6, Last 3, Last Hole.
12. The tournament committee reserves the right to disqualify any player that is found to have purposefully violated HBF Tour Rules, Pace of Play Policy, Handicap Policy, or Player Conduct expectations. *No Refunds will be issued*
13. Scoring will be done immediately following play. ALL Scorecards must be verified, with 2 signatures, and Leaderboard King MUST match the cards.
14. In Case of Weather, Darkness, or any unforeseen reason the event can't be completed, payouts are as follows:
 - a. Tournament will be considered official thru 36 holes.
 - b. If your flight ALL finishes 14 holes, then the event will be official thru 14.
 - c. Completion of all flight participants thru 18 holes.
15. All Scoring will be hosted on the LEADERBOARD KING SOFTWARE.



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HANDICAPS

Handicaps will be determined per the HBF Tour policy. USGA Current and USGA Low will be determined per the players handicaps by Friday 9/11. See policy on www.hbftour.com for more details.

Closest to the Pin—Day 1 Hole #11

- Must Make Par or better to be eligible
- 1 Paid spot per flight

Longest Drive—Day 1 Hole #14

- Must Be in the Fairway
- 1 Paid spot per flight

Longest Putt—Day 1 Hole #9

- MUST be first putt from the green surface
- 1 Paid spot per field
