Format/Rules of Play

Chapman/Pinehurst Format

Both players tee off, then switch their play of golf balls. Meaning that Player A plays Player B's ball and Player A will play Player B's Ball. After the second shots, they then select which ball they will continue to play, and that ball is then played by alternate shot until holed.

Handicapping

Team Handicap is configured by utilizing each players HBF Handicap to convert to the Henry County Course handicap. That determines which player will be deemed Player A and Player B. We will then give Player A 60% and Player B 40% of their handicap combined to create the final team handicap. We have 18 teams competing, creating 2 flights, Caveman and Cambridge. Players competing from gold tees will receive a 20% reduction from their White tee course adjusted handicap.

Tees

All men aged 54 and younger = White Tees - 6300 Yards

All men aged 55 and over = Gold Tees (HBF Adjusted) - 5800 Yards

All women = Gold Tees

Pace of Play Expectations

4:30 (15 Min per hole)

Each Group off pace of play by more than 15 minutes will be given a warning. A second instance of poor pace of play will result in a 1 stroke team penalty for the group.

Scoring

Paper Scorecard & Live Scoring via Leaderboard King Software

Paper Scorecard is the official document used to finalize the tournament, each scorecard must be turned in with 2 signatures, 1 from each team. Report direction to clubhouse at completion of play. Once submitted and signed, scores are final.

Skins (Optional)

\$60 Skins Pot Per Team (This includes both Net and Gross)

For this event there will be 1 large pot for skins

Prizes per Flight

Penalty Areas

HBF Standard rule - All lost balls within the boundaries (white stakes) of the property will be played as a lateral hazard

All balls hit outside the boundary of the course will have to rehit from the same position with a 1 stroke penalty
